Blackwater Valley Countryside Trust Privacy Notice

This Privacy Notice tells you what to expect when the Blackwater Valley Countryside Trust collects personal information. It applies to information we collect on this form and elsewhere about you and to members and trustees of the Trust; volunteers; speakers and other event organisers; participants in events; applicants or grants; and people who use our website and our Facebook page.

Who we are and how to contact us

We are the Blackwater Valley Countryside Trust, company number 04898996, charity no. 1109424. Our address is Ash Lock Cottage, Government Road, Aldershot, Hampshire GU11 2PS. We can be contacted at this address or by email to our Data Controller at chair@bvct.org.uk.

What information we collect from you and what we do with it

The provision of information by you on page 1, at events and on our website and Facebook page is entirely voluntary. We collect this information to manage the membership of the Trust so that we can send you newsletters and event invitations, to process orders for any products you purchase from us, to record attendance at our events, so that we can process grant applications under our Small Grants Scheme, and for administration and regulatory purposes.

What we will not do with your data

We will not sell or rent your personal information to third parties or transfer it abroad, nor will it be used for automated decision making.

Who might we share your information with and why?

We share your information with trusted third parties for administrative purposes. These organisations have systems to protect your data and will not share your data with third parties.

We use Membermojo to administer and store membership records including applications and renewals, payments, and email distribution. We use Eventbrite for online event registration and administration. We use Virgin Money Giving to collect donations to the Trust. We use Mailchimp to mail our newsletters. Your information may also be shared with our partnership organisation, the Blackwater Valley Countryside Partnership and Hampshire County Council for administration purposes.

How long do we keep hold of your information?

We will not retain it for longer than is necessary to comply with legal requirements.

How can I access the information you hold about me?

You can write to us or email us at the addresses provided above. If we do hold information about you, you can ask us to correct any mistakes by contacting us and providing us with the correct information.

Your rights in respect of your data

You have rights which you can exercise in relation to the information we hold about you. Under data protection law, you have rights including: right of access; right to rectification; right to erasure; right to restriction of processing; right to object to processing; and right to data portability.
